This evaluation form is based on the <u>Professional Competency Areas for Student Affairs Educators</u> which was endorsed by both NASPA and ACPA in 2015. The document identifies and describes the 10 professional competencies required for student affairs practitioners to be successful in their roles. 10	Demonstrated effective stewardship/use of resources, e.g. financial, human, material.
11	Demonstrated a strong understanding of theory and how to apply theory to practice.
12	Demonstrated innovation in their work by creating, altering, or building upon pre- existing programs or services.
13	Communicated with others using effective verbal and non-verbal strategies appropriate to the situation in both one-on-one and small group settings.
14	Was able to identify their strengths as a leader and sought opportunities to develop leadership skills.
15	Gained an understanding of campus culture and the unit's place/role in that culture.
16	Was able to describe and contribute to the vision, mission, and goals of the unit.
17	Identified primary work responsibilities and, with appropriate feedback, craft a realistic self-appraisal of their own strengths and limitations.
18	Articulated meaningful goals for their work and was able to demonstrate how these goals connect to their future professional endeavors.

19	Was able to articulate and describe the development of college students and the conditions and practices that facilitate holistic development.
20	Was able to work independently and produce deliverables with little intervention from others.
